The interested party may at any time exercise the rights of opposition, access, portability, rectification, limitation and deletion of data.

Additional Information

BGB GIOVANNI BOZZETTO SA (henceforth, “Bozzetto”) complies fully with the regulations on the protection of personal data and, in particular, with the REGULATION (EU) 2016/679 OF THE EUROPEAN PARLIAMENT AND OF THE COUNCIL of April 27th 2016 on the protection of individuals with regard to the processing of personal data and to the free movement of such data and is hereby revoked the Directive 95/46/CE (henceforth “**RGPD**”), so that the processing of personal information provided by the data subject/client, (henceforth, the “**interested party**”) in requesting a specific service for which you give us your data through any medium shall be carried out in compliance with the applicable legal guarantees and obligations.

In compliance with the current legislation, Bozzetto has implemented the appropriate technical and organisational measures to guarantee an appropriate level of security, and also avoid the loss, misuse, alteration, non-authorized access and the theft of data provided by the interested party. In the same manner, Bozzetto guarantees that they comply with the duty of secrecy and confidentiality with regard to the personal data provided by the interested party.

I. Purpose and legitimacy with which we process personal data.

In regards to the processing of personal data we are provided with, or any other data that might arise as a consequence of the performance of the service that you entrust us with. You are hereby informed, that this data will be incorporated into the existing data processing system, whose ownership and responsibility is BGB GIOVANNI BOZZETTO SA with address in Antepardo, 7 – Pol. Ind. de Lantarón 01213 Salcedo (Álava), expressly consenting to the processing of such personal data in a lawful, loyal, transparent, adequate, pertinent, limited, exact and updated manner.

- Management of the request, in your case, of the specific service carried out by the interested party.
- Compliance with legal obligations.

II. How long we will keep the data.

The personal data provided will be kept as long as the contractual relationship between the parties is maintained or until the deletion is requested by the interested party.

III. Communication of data

Regarding the communication of data, it is expressly reported that the personal information of the interested party will not be communicated to third parties legal obligation, and except the organizations that collaborate with BGB GIOVANNI BOZZETTO SA for the provision of services and the proper management of the company, in which case, only with the purposes and uses exclusively necessary for the development of its activity and for which its services were required, not being able to use the same for a different purpose.

IV. Obligations of the controller

Corresponds to Bozzetto:

- a. Implement the appropriate technical and organizational measures to ensure and be able to demonstrate that the processing is in accordance with the legislation in force.
- b. Adopt the data protection policies.
- c. Ensure that the Privacy Officer participates in an adequate and timely manner in all matters relating to the protection of personal data.
- d. Keep a register of processing activities in the event of processing personal data that pose a risk to the rights and freedoms of the interested party, and/or in a non-occasional manner, or that involves the processing of special categories of data and/or data relating to convictions and infringements.
- e. process personal data only on the basis of documented instructions from the Controller, including with regard to transfers of personal data to a third country or an international organization, unless he or she is obliged to do so under the law of the Union or of the Member States applicable to the supervisor; in such a case, the supervisor shall inform the controller of that legal requirement prior to processing, unless such law prohibits it for important reasons of public interest. International transfers of personal data, where applicable, must comply with the protocol established by the Spanish Data Protection Agency, or any national or Community legislation. To attend indistinctly the exercises of right established in the current legislation in Protection of Personal Character Data.
- f. Ensure that people authorized to process personal data have committed to respect confidentiality, or are subject to a statutory obligation of confidentiality.
- g. Take all appropriate technical and organizational measures to ensure a level of safety appropriate to the risk of the treatment.

- h. Notification of breaches of personal data security. In the event of breach of the security of personal data, unless it is unlikely that such breach of security constitutes a risk to the rights and freedoms of natural persons, BOZZETTO shall notify the Spanish Data Protection Agency within 72 hours after it has become aware of the incident, describing the nature of the breach, the possible consequences that may result and the measures adopted or proposed to remedy the security breach; and if possible, the categories and approximate number of interested parties and data affected shall be made known. Likewise, BOZZETTO will notify the interested parties, as soon as possible, when the breach of the security of personal data is likely to entail a high risk to the rights and freedoms of natural persons, describing the possible consequences that might result and the measures adopted or proposed to remedy the security breach.

V. Data protection rights

The interested party will be able to exercise, if it wishes to and at any moment, the rights of access, rectification and suppression of data, as well as request that the treatment of his personal data be limited, to oppose to the same one, to request the portability of his data, as well as not to be object of automated individual decisions, sending a communication in writing to the following email address privacy@bozzetto.es or physical address C/Antepardo, 7 - Pol.
